Love to have dinner with Richard Branson...



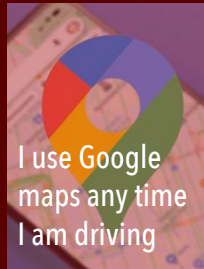
...an unbelievably creative and open minded CEO - wonder if he likes Mexican?

I graduated from George Whittell High School in Lake Tahoe, and was Class President all 4 years (or never "Unelected" as I like to say).



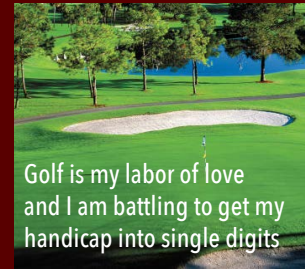
My first summer job was laying sprinklers for a builder - so arguably I have always been in the real estate biz.

My favorite quote is "Do or Do Not...there is no Try" - Yoda

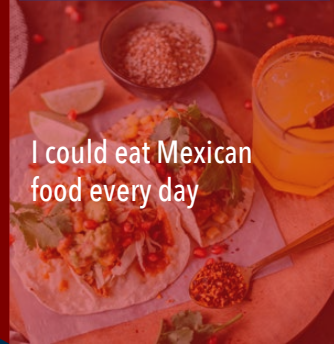


I use Google maps any time I am driving

I could eat Mexican food every day

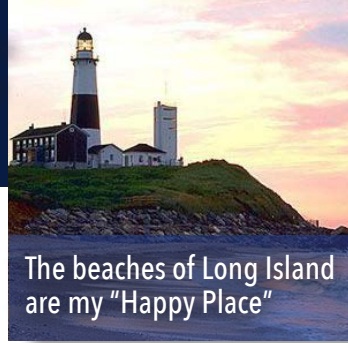
The most important traits a person could have are Honesty & Hard Work - everything else is conversation.
